### Opportunity Details

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In-Hospital Volunteering Phoenix Children's Hospital Main Campus

- Age requirements
  - Family Volunteers- ages 13-15 volunteering 1:1 with their legal guardian
  - Youth Applicants - ages 15-17 years (limited availability, not available at all locations)
  - Adult Applicants - ages 18 years and older
- Commit to a 2-4 hour shift, once a week for a minimum 100 hour commitment over a 6 to 12 month period.
- Must be able to communicate effectively in English (second language skills are a plus)
- Successful completion of background investigation for adult applicants
- Provide proof of immunization or immunity to measles, mumps rubella (MMR), Varicella and Tdap
- Receive an annual flu shot and TB test (provided by PCH)
- Pass a drug test
- Complete initial Health Screening (included in the applications process)
- Meet the physical requirements and position competencies of volunteering (as determined by volunteer opportunity)
